Dear Parishioners,

Today we will pause our bulletin series on the Bible to say a few words about Catholic Charities. As most of you know, Catholic Charities has closed the soup kitchen down the street. Unfortunately, this has drawn a lot of undeserved criticism. While I personally do not know all of the details of this situation, I can pass along two facts to you: 1. The building that houses the soup kitchen is in need of major repairs; 2. Catholic Charities will use its new food truck to continue providing meals to those in need here in Pottsville.

The advantage of the food truck is that it allows Catholic Charities to serve not only Pottsville, but locations throughout the county. Catholic Charities is currently working on establishing a schedule for the food truck and collecting enough volunteers to serve meals at each location. Volunteers are also needed to help prepare the meals at Holy Family's parish center (the former Hillcrest). 
