The cruise ship orchestra's drummer began a sustained drum roll as "Marvo, the world's greatest magician" solemnly declared: "I will now make Pietro the Parrot disappears right before your eyes." The drum beat got louder as the audience members for the evening simultaneously held their breath. Marvo dramatically approached his parrot as it sat on its perch. 
